To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS Hiram Harris of Columbia County, New York has applied in the General Land Office of the United States, a duplicate of the Map of the Land Office at Detroit, showing a portion, and full payment has been made by the said Hiram Harris according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 27th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands" for the North West quarter of the North West fractional quarter of Section Two and Township One North of Range, Town One East in the district of lands subject to sale at Detroit, Michigan Territory, containing fifty one acres and seventy eight hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Survey General, which said land has been purchased by the said Hiram Harris.

NOW KNOW YE That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the requirements of Congress as aforesaid, have granted, and provided, that the said Hiram Harris and his heirs, do and their heirs and assigns, shall and lawfully may, hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Hiram Harris and to his heirs and assigns forever.
